

PE Funding and Allocation

2014-2015

For the last 2 years, the government has funded £150 million per annum to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport - will be allocated to primary school head teachers. The money must be used to improve the provision of PE, school sport and Healthy Living.

PE and school sport play a very important part in the life of North Newton Primary School. We believe that PE and school sport contribute to the holistic development of our children and through participation, our children build and learn more about our key values such as respect, co-operation and kindness for themselves and others.

We are therefore delighted to be able to report our careful spending to support the development of PE and school sport in the following ways;
