

PE Funding and Allocation

2015-2016

For the last 3 years, the government has funded £150 million per annum to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport - will be allocated to primary school head teachers. The money must be used to improve the provision of PE, school sport and Healthy Living.

PE and school sport play a very important part in the life of North Newton Primary School. We believe that PE and school sport contribute to the holistic development of our children and through participation, our children build and learn more about our key values such as respect, co-operation and kindness for themselves and others. This is why we have recently used some of this money to 'buy in' to a Festival scheme, organised by SASP to allow all our children to attend at least 4 festivals in the 2015/16 academic year.

We are therefore delighted to be able to report our careful spending to support the development of PE and school sport in the following ways;

Provision 2015 - 2016	Impact on Children's Learning	Funding allocation
'Buy In' Programme for Festival through SASP	This is to allow all 97 children to experience sporting festivals at least 3 multi-school events locally. Our minibuses are used to transport the children, therefore there is no cost to the parents, however this funding allocation allows some to be put towards the fuel.	£1050
Forest School	Our Reception children have weekly sessions, led by a trained leader, and develop their outdoor learning in a safe environment	£500
Playing Field and Village Hall Rent	With no hall or field on site, we have to rent these nearby facilities in order for children to have experience of all essential aspects of PE.	£2550
Subsidising Swimming	All children attend weekly swimming sessions at Taunton. We use our minibuses, and on one day a coach is hired. The essential impact is that all children can swim confidently by the end of year 6 – many very confident before they are 7. Children also receive certificates when they complete specific stages.	£500
