

## PE Funding and Allocation 2016 - 17

For the last 4 years, the government has funded £150 million per annum to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport - will be allocated to primary school head teachers. The money must be used to improve the provision of PE, school sport and Healthy Living.

PE and school sport play a very important part in the life of North Newton Primary School. We believe that PE and school sport contribute to the holistic development of our children and through participation, our children build and learn more about our key values such as respect, co-operation and kindness for themselves and others. This is why we have recently used some of this money to 'buy in' to a Festival scheme, organised by SASP to allow all our children to attend at least 4 festivals in the 2016-17 academic year.

We are therefore delighted to be able to report our careful spending to support the development of PE and school sport in the following ways;

Provision 2016 - 17	Impact on Children's Learning	Allocation
'Buy In' Programme for Festival through SASP	This is to allow all 93 children to experience sporting festivals at least 4 multi-school events locally. Positive impact to promote healthy living, and active bodies as well as learning to develop socially with other children in different school – essential for a small school! Our minibuses are used to transport the children. Funding allocation allows minimal towards fuel cost.	<b>£1500</b>
Forest School	Reception children have weekly sessions, led by a trained leader, and develop their outdoor learning in a safe environment. Resources are purchased and replaced when needed. Minimal fuel cost used to transport children.	<b>£500</b>
Playing Field and Village Hall Rent	With no hall or field on site, we have to rent these nearby facilities in order for children to have experience of all essential aspects of PE. Further example of healthy body and mind – sport plays a vital part of our school life.	<b>£2550</b>
Subsidising Swimming	All children attend weekly swimming sessions at Taunton. We use our minibuses, and on one day a coach is hired. The essential impact is that all children can swim confidently by the end of year 6 – many very confident before they are 7. Children also receive certificates when they complete specific stages.	<b>£500</b>
PE emergency fund	Reserve for essential PE spending. To ensure small contingency to allow for emergency spending when needed. Positive impact – child to be able to take part in football (shinpads) or swimming (towels/costume)	<b>£164</b>
