13	Communication not as good as in previous years - too many last-minute texts to parents.	Thank you for this - we will try to address this. Having the Headteacher teaching x3 days makes communication as well as many other aspects far more challenging than in previous years when the budget was far more impressive.
1	My child feels they could be given more challenge	We will investigate further extension work.
9	Those children who are consistently good and work hard don't get the recognition they deserve	A shame if any child feels like this. As a staff we will work harder to address this.
9	My child feels they are happy with the way negative behaviour is dealt with quickly and effectively	Thank you - we do try to do this.
13	Despite negative comments from other parents, we feel school communication is excellent and you can't do much more.	Thank you - we will never please everyone, and always try our best.
5	Too much security!	Agreed - but it is a sad reflection on today's society, and in direct response with other schools following serious incidents nationally and internationally.
14	No I don't use it - I should use it more as it will help.	The website hopefully can help support in many ways.
13	Like the reminder texts - really helpful for me.	Thank you - but these do cost every time texts are sent out.
	I don't know why children are not allowed to play on the equipment at the end of the day. A sign should be erect saying 'at parent's risk after 3.15', surely that's then in their hands. Confusing for little ones who don't understand.	Thank you - we would prefer children to leave the school grounds, with their adult, when school finishes safely.
5	All the new fencing and security is overkill - makes it look / feel like a prison!	Sorry you feel like this - we are in line with many other schools, but still feel our site is clean, tidy and safe for our pupils.
9	Poor behaviour of some kids impacting on other students!	This is something we continue to address - thank you for your comment.
9	Good children are often left to their own devices and not recognised for their progress and achievements or given reassurances when doing well. There is a Celebration Assembly, but sometimes a bit of encouragement in other areas would help boost confidence.	In class time, we celebrate good work. We give a variety of rewards in Celebration Assembly and celebrate out of school successes. We must try harder to ensure these children are always given praise as they consistently do their best, behave themselves and always work hard.
6	This has greatly improved now we only have 1 teacher, rather than 2.	One class teacher is always preferable, but a job share is essential at times.
13	Text reminders in the first week rather than in Newsletter would help.	Thank you - texts are always helpful - agreed.
9	There is inconsistency with dealing with poor behaviour	This is a concern - I would like to discuss this further if you would kindly get in contact with me to share your view and specifics.
9	Although overall very happy, my child is fed up with some children whose behaviour impacts on the learning of others. At times, other poor behaviour is overlooked.	Every class teacher is very keen to avoid disruptive pupils impacting on others. We will monitor this - thank you for your comment.
6	Agree - so beginning of class isn't disrupted, unless an emergency. Need to know basis	Thank you for appreciating the first few minutes in the day is vitally important to settle the children, ready to learn.
